TECHNICIANS ONLY SESSIONS

The Purdue conference will offer two special classes intended only for technicians. They are designed to enhance technicians' on-the-job knowledge, while networking with colleagues from across the country. LIFETIME LEARNING TAX CREDIT

CONTINUING CERTIFICATION HOURS (CCH/CEU)

INDIANA – The Office of the Indiana State Chemist has approved Continuing Certification Hours toward the renewal of your pesticide applicator license. Credits are indicated following each topic on the reverse side of this brochure. Written instructions will be provided at registration to guide you through the procedure required to obtain credits.

OTHER STATES

Applications have been submitted to the remaining 49 states' regulatory agencies requesting CCH approval for conference attendance. While we cannot guarantee your state will approve our program, we have received approval from as many as 45 states in recent years. Please bring your pesticide applicator/certificate number(s) with you; most states require this information to properly credit attendance.
